Why You Should Partner with JDRF

Your investment in JDRF is making real, tangible progress toward easing the burden and complications of type 1 diabetes (T1D), until a cure is found. Here are some examples of current projects and progress:

Glucose Responsive Insulin – A form of insulin that only works when the glucose levels start to rise and remains inactive when blood sugar levels are in proper range. This would lessen the need for injections and help maintain tighter glucose controls.

Encapsulation – First human trials of an easily implanted device containing beta and/or islet cells surrounded by a protective shield. The encapsulated cells sense glucose levels and produce and release insulin as needed while protecting them from the autoimmune attack. This could create insulin independence for a person for up to two years, virtually eliminating the relentless daily management for those living with T1D.

Artificial Pancreas – Like the body's own pancreas, the artificial pancreas combines monitoring technology with insulin pumps to provide the right amount of insulin at the right time. The first generation of these devices are available, but the fully functioning ones are still in testing phases.

Regeneration/Restoration – This is the full biologic cure. We know that in almost all those with T₁D, there is minimal insulin production. The research is determining the best way to get the body's beta cells to produce enough insulin to sustain life and at the same time, prevent the autoimmune response from destroying those cells.

Prevention – To prevent the autoimmune attack on beta cells, JDRF is working on two different types of vaccines – viral, which would stop those triggering viruses which sometimes trigger the onset of T1D and Beta Cell Autoantigen – these are similar to allergy shots and train the body not to attack beta cells. JDRF is also examining the impact of inflammation which is one of the causes of beta cell death; boosting beta cell survival through use of a combination of drugs.
